



TUCKSHOP

Welcome to all parents to our Tuckshop Program for 2019. Volunteering to help at the tuckshop is a great way of getting to know other families and is also a very enjoyable experience.

Some useful information:

- ◆ To order lunches correct money is placed in brown paper lunch bags (available from the supermarket) clearly marked with name, class, food and drink items required for your child's lunch. (We also have a reusable lunch bag available to purchase for \$8 each)
- ◆ If change is required it will be taped to the corner of the bag
- ◆ On arrival at class each morning your child will place his/her lunch order in the class esky and this is then taken to the tuckshop by the lunch order monitors. They then return before lunch to collect the class lunches.
- ◆ NO FROZEN ITEMS or NACHOS are to be ordered in lunches. These are sold over the counter at recess and lunch.

Tuckshop is a service provided by our school and is under the Guidelines of the NSW Canteen Association and a local dietician.

We require volunteer parents to make this possible:

Our roster is run on a monthly basis and if you can be at the tuckshop by 9.30 and normal finishing time is 2pm. Times of serving are recess 10.50 – 11.20am or lunch 1.25 – 1.55pm.

There are some "Special Days" run by the Tuckshop that adds variety and excitement to the children's days e.g. St. Patrick's Day (Green Food), Book Weeks, BBQ Days to name a few.
